Sub:- M.Vs. - Compliance of new emission measures applicable from 1.4.2000 - Amendment in Central Motor Vehicles Rules 115 - clarification issued - reg.

Ref:- 1. Sub Rule 10 of Rule 115 of CMV Rules 1989.
2. Central Government notification No.GSR 493 (E) dated 28.8.97 of the Ministry of Surface Transport, Government of India.

As per Sub-Rule 10 of Rule 115 of CMV Rules 1989 all vehicles manufactured on and after 1.4.2000 should comply with the emission norms prescribed in the notification No.GSR 493 (E) dated 28.8.97 of the Ministry of Surface Transport, Government of India. But the emission norms specified above is not applicable to the vehicles manufactured prior to 1.4.2000. Your attention is also invited to the CMV Rule 122 regarding the embosment of Chassis number and engine number and date of manufacture while registering the vehicle after 1.4.2000 for the compliance of CMV Rule 115(10).

All Registering Authorities are therefore, directed to register such vehicles manufactured before 1.4.2000 without insisting to the new emission norms specified in the notification number GSR 493 (E) dated 28.8.97.
