In the letter first cited the Ministry of Surface Transport, Lelhi have further clarified that as per Section 2 (29) of the Vehicles Act 1988 any vehicle constructed or adapted to carry than six passengers excluding the driver may be categorised than six passengers excluding the driver may be categorised than Bus'. The letter also clarifies that while considering registration of such vehicles in the name of the individual the same may be allowed under the category of "non-transport clear transport vehicle" depending upon the declaration given the individual owner regarding their end use. In case registration such vehicles is to be considered in the name of company, it may allowed under the category of "Transport Vehicle" only as per than 2 (47) read with section 2 (33) of the Motor Vehicles Act.

All Registering Authorities and Additional Registering Authorities are directed to take note of the above clarification while sidering application for registration of vehicles designed to more than six passengers, excluding driver. Circular No.34/98 10/99 stand modified to the above extend. Receipt of Circular Lacknowledged.
