CIRCULAR NO. 8/2006

An instance has come to notice in which Driving Licenses were distributed to the applicants by the owner of a lubricant shop. It is gathered that this person also owns a Driving School and that Licenses were distributed by him in this capacity to those who got training in his Driving School.

The above instance has come to adverse notice in the Media. Where allegations of corruption have been raised against the concerned officials in this regard. It has brought bad name to the Department.

In the circumstances cited above, it is hereby ordered that in future Driving Licenses will be sent to the applicants by registered post in the respective addresses. The applicants may be requested at the time of filing their applications to furnish self-addressed envelopes with sufficient stamps for this purpose. In rare cases where self-addressed envelopes are not available the Driving Licenses will be sent to the applicants at Government cost. On no account should the plea be taken that stamps are not available. Sufficient stamps should be procured well in advance.

This circular direction will take immediate effect.

Receipt of the circular shall be acknowledged.
