Sub: - Motor Vehicles - Tax liability - Grant \_ of exemption without nicisty-prior non use intimation in respect of vehicles stopped by the authorities by statutory orders for receous of mechanical defects - Instructions issued.

On a reference made by this office, the Government had clarified that exemption from payment of tax can be granted in cases where a Motor Vehicle is stopped by the authority by statutory orders for reasons of mechanial defects even if no intimation is received. Copy of the said Gevernment clarification had been sont to the subordinate officers wide reference cited (Copy enclosed).

Instances of rejection of applications for tax exemption for the periods of non-use due to the stoppage of vehicles by statutory orders issued by competent authorities for reasons of mechanical derects have been brought to the notice of this office. It reems that the texation authorities are not aware of the clarification issued by the Government. Therefore the taxation authorities are requested to note the Government Clarification while disposing of the applications for tax exemption in such cases.
