Sub: ~~Motor Vehicles~~ *Registration - Alteration* Dept. - Replacement of Assembled Engine or parts of Engine - irregularities - directions issued -

Ref: Govt. letter No.32021/M1/92/PW&T dated 20.2.92.

An instance came to the notice of a Registering Authority, in which permission was sought for engine alteration. The proposed engine was assembled by using spare parts and on that ground the said application was rejected by the Registering Authority. Aggrieved by the decision of Registering Authority the applicant has filed a petition before the government. The government after examining the case rejected the petition and upheld the decision of the said registering authority on the grounds that the engine referred there in is not manufactured by any of the approved manufacturers in India or abroad. Assembling engine by using spare parts and fitting the same in a vehicle is illegal. There is no provision in Motor Vehicles Act/Rules in favour of according sanction for replacement of existing engine by an assembled or such unauthorised engine.

2. The above rule position and decision of Government is brought to the notice of all Registering Authorities, Additional Registering Authorities and Assistant Registering Authorities and request for strict compliance.
