**CIRCULAR NO.10/2007**

Sub : - MVs. Dept.-Guideline relating to grant of Temporary Permits to the Stage Carriages.

It is brought to the notice of State Transport Authority that the Secretaries of Regional Transport Authorities are granting Temporary Permits for Stage Carriages for a period of 20 days instead of granting for 4 months and it is understood that in the case of renewal of regular permits under section 87 (i) (d) of MV Act 1988, issuing of Temporary permit for 20 days continuously creates avoidable additional work in the Regional Transport Offices and hardship to the bus operators. As the delay in granting renewal of regular permit is mainly for want of concurrence from other Regional Transport Authorities. Regional Transport Officers should ensure that granting of concurrence is done without delay. As different procedures are being followed by different Regional Transport Authorities, it has become necessary to issue instruction in this regard for uniformity. The State Transport Authority has looked into the matter and on a careful study, it is directed that Temporary Permits under section 87(i)(d) of MV Act shall be issued for a minimum period of 4 months. The practice of granting 20 days Temporary Permits continuously shall be avoided. The above direction shall be complied with scrupulously. Receipt of this circular shall be acknowledged.
