Licensing Authorities refuse to entertain applications for authorisation to drive autorickshaws even after the applicants have passed the test of competence referred to in sub Section (3) of Section 9 of the M.V.Act, 1988. As per 3rd provise to Rule 6 of the K.M.V.Rules, 1989, the experience for a period of one year in driving light motor vehi les shall not be necessary in the case of an applicant for authorisation to drive an autorickshaw or a motorised cycle rickshaw.

fore, the Licensing authorities are directed to comply with the above provisions and to grant authorisation along with bad as provided in Rule 11 of the KMV.Rules to drive autorickshaws without insisting on experience for a period of one year subject to payment of the prescribed fee and other statutory provisions.
