Sub: Motor Vehicles Pept - Prevention of malpractices committed in the assignment of vehicles coming from outside States.

Government letter No.9169/C3/2003/Trans dated 07.08.2003. Ref:

It has come to the notice that most of the Registering Authorities are assigning the vehicles coming from outside states on the strength-of affidavits signed by the persons upon whom the vehicles are to be transferred and the same attested by notary public. No efforts are seriously made by the Registering Authorities to get reply from the authorities from where the vehicles are originally registered.

The above system is encouraging shady Business in vehicle exchange of stolen vehicles and thriving of underworld dealings. Malpratices are possible in this system in which agents and fouts are daily visitors in Regional Transport Officers and Sub Regional Transport Offices. In some cases either the verification letter can be suppressed and shown as sent or bogus reply can be sent confirming that every thing is correct.

In order to avoid such irregularities and malpractices and allied corruption all Registering Authorities are directed to check the Website of the National Crime Records Bureau, New Delhi, the authority which maintains the list of stolen vehicles in reported cases all over India and only after getting "clear signal" by FAX or E-Mail from the original registering authority as recommended by the Director of Vigilance '& Anti Corruption Bureau. Before assignment of new registration mark to a vehicle issued with No Objection Certificate from other States, the NCRB shall be consulted by the Registering The correspondence to the NCRB shall be addressed to the Director, National Crime Records Bureau, East Block-7 R.K.Puram, New Delhi-110066 (INDIA).
