Vide Circular No.20/86 (Ref. No.25389/86 dated 7/86 Target for performances for Assistant Motor Vehicles Inspectors, Motor Vehicles Inspectors and Joint Regional Transport Officers were fixed. No target was fixed for Flying Squad, Mobile Enforcement Squad and Regional Transport Officers. The number of vehicles has increased by 170% from 1986 to 2004 and now there are 27 lakhs of vehicles in Kerala. Field work needs to be made more efficient. There are complaints regarding parallel services by Tempo/Trekker/Omni Buses etc. and that of clandestine taxies through out Kerala. Usually the target fixed by the Department could not be achieved due to lack of efficiency in fieldwork even though there have been constraints of vehicles and manpower. Hence a revised target for field officers is fixed as follows for strict compliance. Deputy Transport Commissioners will take special attention in this case, review the work of each officer during the Zonal Conference, take action against those who do not achieve the target and report to the Transport Commissioner.
