Sub:- Banning the use of colour/high beam bulbs in the headlights of vehicles - reg.

Several complaints have been received from the public about the difficulties due to the use of colour bulbs or neon bulbs in the head lights of the motor vehicles by dazzling. Though there is no express provision in the Act or Rules prohibiting the use of colour bulbs or neon bulbs, use of such bulbs will become an offence if it causes danger or inconvenience by dazzling, as per Rule 360 of the KMV Rules.

Hence all officers are hereby directed to take stringent action against the fitment of colour/high beam bulbs in the head lights of motor vehicles under Rule 177 of KMV Rules 1980, if the bulbs are used causing danger or inconvenience to any person. Receipt of the Circular may be acknowledged.
