Sub: - Automobile Pollution - Enforcement of Rule 115 (7) of Central Motor Vehicles Rules - PUC Certificates in the departmental vehicles - Instructions issued. reg.

Sub Rule 7 of Rule 115 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rule 1989, stipulates that all Motor Vehicles, older than one year from the date of registration shall carry a valid 'Pollution under Control Certificate (PUCC) issued by an agency authorised for this purpose by the State Government.

Our Department has decided to take stringent action against the violation of the above rule. Many vehicles owned by the Transport Department are not complying with this provision. All the vehicles belonging to our department should be tested for Pollution Under Control and to ensure that the PUC Certificate in original is available in the vehicle all the time. We will be enforcing the law stringently from 1st January, 2000. It is also instructed that the driver of the vehicle will be responsible for obtaining and keeping custody of PUC Certificate. All our vehicles should have PUCC by 1st January, 2000. The Circular should be acknowledged by return.
