The Committee on Road Safety appointed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in its meeting held on 21-8-2017, reviewed the performance of the State under Road Safety. The Committee expressed its dissatisfaction over the high accident and fatalities rate in the State. The Committee also stressed on suspension of driving licences for traffic offences, as this will have a deterent effect on traffic rule violators. The Committee further directed to register at least 10 to 15% reduction in accident cases and fatalities rate in the next quarter by strictly enforcing traffic rule regulations such as over speeding, red light jumping, overloading, using mobile phone while driving, drunken driving, driving without helmet etc. But it is much regretted to inform you that accident & fatalities rate during the month of November 2017 is very high compared to corresponding month of previous year and also to the accident rate in previous months of this year.

In the above circumstances the following instructions are issued for strict compliance.
