Government have issued quidelines as per Ist cited for the setting up of Pollution Testing Stations in Kerala and also ordered to issue computerised P.U.C.Cs. from the Pollution Testing stations by incorporating the photograph of the vehicle being tested. Directions were also issued to take action against the testing centres who are violating the guidelines already issued and also to ensure proper functioning of the pollution Testing station. An instance is brought to the notice wherein the R.T.O Kozhikode cancelled the licence issued to one testing centre for

An instance is brought to the notice wherein the R.T.O Kozhikode cancelled the licence issued to one testing centre for violation of guidelines, but the licencee is reported to be trying to obtain fresh licence in some others name using the same testing premises and the same mechines.

It is needless to point out that such grant of licence in another name but with facilities and equipments of the delenquent licence holder will defeat the purpose of action taken against the delinquent.

In this context, all R.T.Os are directed not to issue licences for pollution Testing Centres with the equipments of the cancelled testing stations and also in the same premises. In case an applicant installs second hand equipment it shall be ensured that the equipments are not used by a delinquent licence holders.
