The Manager - Sales of M/s. Mercedes - Benz India Ltd. has requested to issue necessary instructions to the Registering Authorities to register their imported cars on the basis of customs clearance documents and other procedure, laid down under the Central Motor Vehicle Rules 1989.

As per the reference 2nd cited, the Ministry of Surface Transport, New Delhi, have clarified that the imported vehicles can be registered on the basis of customs clearance documents and other procedure laid down under the CMV Rules 1989. It must, however, be certified that the vehicles meet the safety and emission norms as per the Motor Vehicle Act 1988 and Rules made thereunder.

Hence all the Registering Authorities and Additional Registering Authorities are requested to register the vehicle Mercedes Benz MB 140K/MD 100 Vehicles with seating capacity of 15/12 subject to the provision of M.V. Act and Rules.
