Sub: - Realisation of Arrears of Tax under the Revenue Recovery Act and other means -

According to the present practice, after the D.C.B. for each quarter is finalised, revenue recovery steps are being initiated by the Regional Transport Officers as a matter of course, which results in a large number of cases being referred to the Revenue Department, including those where arrears could be realised without resorting to revenue recovery steps. When such a large number of cases are sent to the revenue department, the more important cases get lost among the relatively trivial ones hampering quick recovery of maximum dues. In the last conference of Regional Transport Officers held at Alwaye it was decided that only cases in which Department Officers can not themselves collect the amount need be referred to the District Collectors.

2. When Revenue Recovery steps are taken on a person who resides outside the District or State, the revenue recovery certificate is sent to the local District Collector who in turn requests the concerned Collector to realise the amount under Revenue Recovery steps. Very often there is delay in the recovery of these amounts from persons residing in other Districts or States. It is, therefore, ordered that the Regional Transport Officers should address the local Regional Transport Officers in this State or the other State as the case may be requesting them to use their good offices to collect the arrears. Revenue Recovery certificates should be sent to the District Collectors only after it is found that the arrears cannot be realised by the Departmental Officers themselves. Similarly if requisitions are received from Regional Transport Officers of Tamilnadu, the Regional Transport Officers of this state should use their good Offices to collect the arrears.

3. Regarding the amount now due from the operators in Tamilnadu a list of such cases may be prepared and sent to the Regional Transport Officers concerned. In cases, there is no response from the Regional Transport Offices of Tamilnadu State, the matter may be brought to the notice of this office to be taken up with Transport Commissioner, Tamilnadu. The receipt of the circular will be acknowledged.
