Attention is invited to the above reference. In the meeting held by Hon'ble Chief Minister and Hon'ble Minister for Transport, Food and Civil Supplies, the representatives of transport contractors raised some complaints that the vehicle carrying hazardous goods are detained unnecessarily in the Motor Vehicles Check Posts en route and are being harassed by Motor Vehicles Department officials. According to them, due to this unnecessary detention, the truck drivers/ operators are not in a position to carry the loads and reach the destination in time. The delay of Liquified Petroleum Gas Tankers to their respective destinations causes shortage of Liquified Petroleum Gas and unseen damages to the economy of our country.

In this circumstance you are directed to avoid unnecessary delay in check posts while checking vehicles carrying hazardous or dangerous goods. These vehicles should be permitted to pass as and when they come to the check post subject to verification of mandatory stipulations and without any undue harassment and delay.
