### CIRCULAR NO.24/98

Sub: - Motor Driving Schools - Inspection - Instructions issued.

It is noticed that the conditions stipulated in 1989 Central Motor Vehicles Rules 24 and 27 are not being adhered to by many licensees of Motor Driving Schools. This adversely affects the standard of training imparted by such schools.

Therefore, it is decided that all licensed Motor Driving Schools will be periodically inspected by officers of the rack of RTC/Joint RTO/MVI. With a view to achieve uniformity in inspections, a Check List is prescribed as appendix \*\*A\*\* to this Circular. A copy of the Check List should be enclosed to the Show Cause Motice, if any, issued to the licensee propositing to revoke the licence. A proforma for issue of Show Cause Motice is prescribed as appendix 'B' to this Circular. The time allowed for submission of explanation may not be less than 7 days and not more than 15 days.

It is expected that all Motor Driving Schools will be inspected from time to time and remedial steps taken so that well equipped schools are encouraged and the others given opportunity to attain the required standards.
