Attention is invited to the reference cited where all office heads where directed to depute an officer from their office for training in connection with the above subject. The list of participants in the training is attached with this letter. The head of offices from which no officer participated in the meeting must make necessary arrangements in consultation with their nearby offices to get their field officers trained in the procedure for tagging the devices. No complaints in respect to lack of training will be entertained as all offices were directed to depute their staff for training.

Also all office heads should take necessary steps to contact the school authorities in their jurisdiction making them aware of the fact that their vehicles should be fitted with one of the GPS devices which is listed in the department website. The regional Transport Officers should contact the Deputy Director of Education of their jurisdiction and inform the matter. The copy of the letter informing the Director of Public instruction about the matter, attached herewith, may be produced before them. Since the implementation is the first step towards achieving the goal of utilising GPS system for monitoring public transport and thereby improving road safety sincere efforts from the part of all office heads is essential. The guidelines for implementation and list of franchisees of approved vendors are uploaded in the website. The Regional Transport officers are directed to inspect the franchisees through their subordinates to ascertain whether the franchises are equipped with the minimum facilities for conducting the fitment and tagging on or before 05.09.2018.
