NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 17 October, 2013

G.S.R. 692(E) --- The following draft rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which the Central Government proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 27, 41, 50, and 110 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988) is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after expiry of a period of 30 days from the date on which the copies of this notification as published in the Gazette of India are made available to the Public.

2. Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft rules within the period as specified will be considered by the Central Government.

3. The objections or suggestions, if any, to these draft rules be sent to the Joint Secretary (Transport), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Transport Bhawan, New Delhi, within the period, specified above.

DRAFT RULES

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Motor Vehicles (3rd Amendment) Rules, 2013.

(2) Save as otherwise provided in these rules, they shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 (hereafter referred as the said rules), in rule 125 C, for sub-rule (1), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) On and after the 1st day of April, 2014, the testing and approval for body building of new models of buses shall be in accordance with AIS:052 (Revision 1)-2008, as amended from time to time, for vehicles mentioned therein, till the corresponding BIS specifications are notified under the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 1986 (63 of 1986):

Provided that the provisions of this rule shall be applicable for the existing models on and after the 1st day October, 2014”;

3. In the said rules, in Form 22-A-

(i) for the brackets, word and figures “[see rules 47(g), 115, 124(2), 126A and 127(1), 127(2)]”, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“[see rules 47(g), 115, 124(2), 125 C, 126A, 127(1) and 127(2)]”;

(ii) for PART-II, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“PART-II
(to be issued by the body builder)

Certified that the body of the following vehicle has been fabricated by us and the same complies with the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, and the rules made thereunder:

1.Brand name of the vehicle_____

2.Chassis No._____

3.Engine No./Motor No. _____

4.Bus Body Builder Accreditation Certificate Number _____ Date _____ Valid upto date _____

5. Bus Body Type Approval Certificate Number _____ Date _____ issued by the approved Test Agency

(Signature of the body builder)

[Form 22-A Part II shall be issued with the signature of the body builder duly printed in the Form itself by affixing facsimile signature in ink under the hand and seal of the body builder.

Note:- PART-II shall be applicable for new model of buses on or after the 1st April, 2014 and for the existing model of buses on or after the 1st day of October, 2014]".

2. Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft rules within the period as specified will be considered by the Central Government;

3. Objections or suggestion, if any, may be sent to the Joint Secretary (Transport), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Transport Bhawan, New Delhi – 110 001.

DRAFT RULES

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Motor Vehicles (4th Amendment) Rules, 2013.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, in sub-rule (8) of rule 93, the proviso shall be omitted.
