Sub:- Motor Vehicles Department – Surprise check of Senior Deputy Transport Commissioner (Taxation) at Sub Regional Transport Office, Changanacherry – Irregularities detected – Conducted Driving Test / CF Test etc in the absence of MVI's – Instructions issued – Reg.

Ref:- Inspection report dated 06/12/2013 from Senior Deputy Transport Commissioner (Taxation).

During the course of surprise check by Senior Deputy Transport Commissioner (Taxation) at the Driving Test / CF Test grounds attached to the Sub Regional Transport Office, Changanacherry, it was noticed that the tests were conducted by the AMVI's in the absence of MVI's who were authorized to conduct the tests. The action of the MVI's who authorized this duty to AMVIs on the date of check was violative of the directions contained in the Circular No. 11/2011 and Letter No. G5/7899/TC/2011. On enquiry it is learnt that this unlawful practice is being followed by a good number of officers. This is not allowable and against the interest of the department in view of public safety.

In the circumstances all the RTO's/JRTO's are directed to ensure that the procedure and instructions laid down for the conduct of Driving Test/CF Tests are being followed scrupulously by the team and the driving/CF tests should be conducted properly. It is also directed to instruct the concerned that driving test and CF Test are not to be clubbed together according to the convenience of the officers.
