Sub:- Classification of Omni Buses Owned by Companies & Institutions and Government Departments as Non-Transport Vehicles - Instructions issued.

Ref:- 1. Letter No. MT-11036/13/97-MVL dated 24.7.98 of Ministry of Surface Transport, New Delhi.
2. This Office Circular No. 2/97 dated 15.4.97 and No. 1/98 dated 5.2.1998.

In their letter dated 24.7.1998, the Ministry of Surface Transport, New Delhi, have clarified that the vehicles having seating capacity of 6/12 passengers plus driver, registered in the name of companies and used for private purposes only, may be categorized as Non-transport Vehicle after getting an undertaking from the applicant that such vehicles shall be used only for private purposes and not for any hire or reward.

In modification to this office Circular Nos. 2/97 and 1/98 it is now ordered that vehicles with seating capacity of 6/12 plus driver, owned by Companies and Institutions as well as State/Central Governments and used exclusively for private purposes connected with the Registered Owner may be categorized as Non-transport vehicles, after getting an undertaking from the applicant that such vehicles shall be used only for private purpose and not for any hire or reward. at pe
