WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala is of the opinion that for the purpose of providing an efficient, adequate, economical and properly co-ordinated passenger road transport service, it is necessary in public interest that the passenger road transport service as per the particulars in the Schedule given below should be run and operated by the State Transport Undertaking, in supersession of Notifications given in the Annexure hereto published for general information;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala in C. A. No. 4994/2002 had given an undertaking before the Hon'ble Supreme Court to amend the existing Scheme;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala has published a new Scheme, vide GO. (P) No. 20/2008/Trans., dated 6th May, 2008 as S.R.O. No. 444/2008 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 893 dated the 6th May, 2008.

AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in its judgement dated 24th July, 2008 in WP(c) 15194/2008, has struck down clauses (4) and (19) of the said Scheme and thereby the Scheme became inoperative and it has become necessary to publish a Draft Scheme as directed by the High Court;

Now, Therefore, the Government of Kerala hereby publish the following Scheme for general information. Any person affected by the scheme may file his objections addressed to the Secretary to Government, Transport Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram within thirty days from the date of publication of the Scheme in the Gazette, in the manner specified under section 100 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 99 of 1988).

- Route or routes (with their important intermediate points) or the area in relation to which the scheme is proposed
- 2. Route length (in the case of scheme in relation to route or routes only)
- Class of service (Stage carriage/Contract carriage, Goods carriage, mofussil or City or town services in the case of Stage Carriage)
- 4. Whether the services are to be operated by the State Transport Undertaking to the exclusion of other persons or otherwise

Yes, the permits issued in the private sector on or before to 9-5-2006 will be allowed to continue till the dates of expiry of the respective permits. Thereafter temporary permits alone will be granted to them and that too if the STU does not apply for permits in the same routes. When the STU applies for introducing a new service in the above routes, such number of existing private stage carriage permits in the said routes shall not be renewed. The principle
