Attention is invited to the reference cited above NIC had informed that as a solution to avoid heavy load on the primary servers and lack of readiness of backup server to handle the primary server failure it was decided to modify the SMART MOVE in such a way that the TABLE VIEW module to work only from the secondary server. For usage of this module the server has to be configured as per the backup and disaster recovery plan which is recommended in the security Policy Guidelines of SMART MOVE application implementation. It may also be noted that due to the slackness in the proper implementation of the backup policy by the SPMVD is the main reason for the recent issues at RTO Alappuzha.

In this regard you are directed to strictly implement the backup and Disaster Recovery policy as per the guidelines issued earlier. In this regard I am also inform that the response from SPMVD is not satisfactory.
