Sub: Motor Vehicles Department-Acceptance of huge registration fee with
the connivance of vehicle dealers and officials of Motor Vehicles
Department-reg

Your attention is invited to the above references. Vide reference 1st cited, the
Director, , Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau, Thiruvananthapuram has offered the
following recommendations in order to curb the practice of accepting huge amount
by the vehicle dealers for the registration of vehicles

- i. The Registering Authority shall verify all the invoices of the dealer
when the vehicle is proceeding for registration. If it is found that
excess registration charge is obtained by the dealer, registration of
such vehicles can be withheld.
- ii. Instruct the Registering Authority for not renewing the trade
certificate to the dealer if it is found that they are collecting exorbitant
amount from the customer towards the registration charge.

Hence you are directed to verify the invoices produced by the dealer at the
time of registration of the vehicle. If it is found that excess registration charge is
imposed by the dealer the registration of such vehicles must be withheld. Besides if
it is found that the dealers are collecting huge amount from the customer in the
name of registration of vehicles, action should be taken against those dealers as
per the existing provisions of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.
