It is reported from various district that out of the 25 candidates summoned for driving test on a particular day, not all the 25 attend the test, probably due to various inconveniences on their part. This results in under-utilisation of resources on the one hand and increased waiting period for other registered candidates.

Therefore, it is decided that 40 candidates will be assigned to a testing ground for a day and communication sent to them accordingly (as prescribed in item No.11 of Circular 16/98 dated 2-6-1998). All the candidates who appear accordingly will be tested even if their number happens to be more than 25.

It is further clarified that re-testing of failed candidates as instructed in this office letter dated 27-7-1998 will be in addition to the 40 fresh candidates summoned for the day.
