Ref:- This Head Office Circular No.20/98 dated 25.7.1998.


In instruction No.17 in the Circular referred above, it is mentioned that candidates who pass in Part I test but fail in Part II (in any class of vehicles) will be required to re-appear in both parts for that class of vehicle. Such failed candidates may be given a date on the spot for re-appearing in the test on a date which will be exactly one month later. For example, candidates who fail in the test held on 3.8.1998 will be given date 3.9.1998 for re-appearing in the test provided 3.9.1998 is a working day. In case such a date falls on a holiday, the next working day will be assigned to the candidates.

The date for re-appearing will be endorsed at the bottom of Form-4 below the printed portion for furnishing the items in which the candidate has failed. This will be done by use of a rubber stamp worded as given below:

"You are allowed to re-appear for the test on payment of fees on . . . . . (date) without submitting fresh application".

In case the candidate fails again he/she will be required to submit fresh application as prescribed in this Head Office Circular No.16/98.
