Allegation in the surprise check report vide reference 1st cited submitted by the VACB was that a driving school namely Raju Motor Driving School, North Parur had managed to obtain a driving licence in the name of one person after producing a bogus medical certificate regarding eye sight. The vigilance team could not locate the original file leading to the issue of original licence and on interrogation, the Sub-RT Officials testified that the records relating to driving licence need be preserved for only 3 months. Therefore the Director, VACB suggested that the Department shall retain the application for driving licence and connected records for one year, so that the same would be available for investigation if necessary.

Hence all the officers are hereby directed to retain and preserve the records leading to the issue of driving licences for a minimum period of one year.
