Complaints have been received that officers of this department are realising fine for various services, while filing applications on the working day following the holiday on which the time limit of a document expires.


According to General Clause Act if the last day happens to be a holiday the next working day shall be treated as last day for rendering service and fine need not be collected. It is clarified that if the 5th day specified in the Circular happens to be a holiday, the validity of temporary registration shall be upto the next working day.
