Subject: Issuance of the driving licences

Sir/Madam,

1. It has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that the Driving Licences are being issued by the registering authorities to persons who have neither resided in the State nor attended the classes in a driving school within the aforesaid State.
2. It is highlighted that there are conditions in regard to the Age of the applicant for obtaining the Driving Licence as per Section 4 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. Further, the applicant desiring to obtain a driving licence may apply to the licensing authority having the jurisdiction in the area in which he ordinarily resides or carries on business, for the issue of a driving licence as provided in Section 9 of the Driving Licence.
3. An application for a driving licence has to be made in Form 2 and is to be accompanied by the proof of residence and the proof of age as prescribed under Rule 14 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989 (CMVR). Further, that the evidence for the correctness of address or age is prescribed through a list of documents enshrined under Rule 4 of the CMVR 1989.
4. Accordingly, it is hereby advised that the provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 with regard to issuance of Driving Licence be strictly complied with and that the correctness of age and residence and other mandatory conditions be ensured for the issuance of a Driving Licence.
