I am directed to say that after introduction of GST in July 2017, there is no need for having the regular transport check posts at the State Borders. The online data in respect of vehicles and drivers has been strengthened through VAHAN and SARATHI platforms.

2. Accordingly, majority of the States/UTs the Transport check posts have been abolished.

3. It is, therefore, requested that the present status regarding removal of check posts at State Borders may kindly be intimated to the Ministry at the earliest.
