Subject: Registration of the Combine Harvester fitted with the Bharat (TREM) Stage-IIIA & old engines.


Sir,

I am directed to say that this Ministry vide GSR 850 (E) dt 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022, amended rule 115-A of Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989, which is related to the emission norms for the combine harvester, laid down the applicability of TREM Stage -IV emission norms w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023. A transition period was allowed for registration of combined harvesters up to six months after the respective date of implementation i.e up to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that certain manufacturers of combine harvesters are registering their equipment with TREM Stage- IIIA engines which are not in accordance with the provisions of CMVR 1989.

3. As such, States/UTs are advised to look into the matter in respect of combine harvesters registered on and after 01<sup>st</sup> July 2023 and take appropriate action in this regard.
