Your attention is invited to the above references. You are aware of the fact that as per GSR 933(E) dated 28/10/1989 Blood Group in Motor Driving License was made optional. As per Rules 5 (1),(3), 7, 10 (a), 14 (d) and 18 (d) of Central Motor Vehicles Rules in Form 1(A) Blood Group and Rh Factor are optional. Blood Group and Rh Factor have to be noted if the applicant so desires that the information may be noted in his driving license. But as per GSR 521(E) dated 15/07/2008 space is provided to note Blood Group and Rh Factor of the driver in Form 7 under Rule 16(2) of Central Motor Vehicles Rules. In this circumstance you are directed to insist the applicant to produce Form 1 (A) marked with Blood Group and Rh factor of the applicant. You are also directed to note both Blood Group and Rh factor in the Motor Driving License (Form No.7). You are also instructed to take special care to mark Blood Group and Rh Factor in the licenses issued from the date 15/07/2008 since GSR 521(E) came in to force on 15/07/2008.
