
In the judgement in WP© No. 27011/12 filed by before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala against the unauthorised erection of hoardings, advertisement boards, the Hon'ble High Court has directed the Transport Commissioner and Road Safety Commissioner to remove such advertisement boards and hoardings in coordination with Local self Government Institutions. Hence you were directed to take all necessary steps to remove the hoardings and advertisement boards which are found to be a cause of occurrence of traffic blocks and accidents and found distractive to the drivers. You were also directed to invoke the provisions of the Kerala Road Safety Authority Act in consultation with the District Road Safety Councils. All Deputy Transport Commissioners are directed to forward a compliance report in this regard in return.
