S.O..... In exercise of the powers conferred by clause(n) of sub-section (3) of section 66 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Central Government hereby orders that the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 66 of the said Act shall not apply to the following types of transport vehicles used, or to be used, for the purposes of carriage of passengers, namely :-

- (i) A.C. Deluxe Bus (ACX) as defined in the Bus Body Code AIS-052, having a carrying capacity of more than 22 passengers.
