CIRCULAR

Sub: Exhibition of Name boards in Motor vehicles owned/used by judicial officers in the State- regarding.

Ref:- 1. Circular No.5280/M2/94/PW&T dated 25.02.1994.
2. Official Memorandum No. D1(B)77356/2008 dated 22.12.2008 of the High Court of Kerala

As per the reference 1st cited, the Government have issued Instructions for exhibiting name boards in the vehicles owned by Government Department, Public Sector Undertakings etc. As per the reference second cited, the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala had granted permission to all judicial officers in the state to display name plates indicating their designation on their private cars subject to the following conditions: -

- i) The display of name plate on the private car shall not obstruct the view of the number plate of the vehicle.
- ii) The name plate indicating the designation shall be covered when the judicial officer is not in the car concerned.
- iii) The misuse of the permission to display name plate indicating designation shall be viewed seriously by the High Court, and the permission shall be withdrawn in the case judicial officers found to be misusing the permission.

The Registrar, Subordinate Judiciary, High Court of Kerala informed the Government that it would be advisable to have a Government Order in the matter as in the case of the members of the Legislative Assembly permitting them to exhibit plates showing designation on their private car.

In the circumstances, in addition to the instructions already issued, the Government hereby grants permission to all judicial officers in the state to

exhibit name boards indicating their designation in the front and rear of the motor vehicles owned/used by them subject to the following conditions:-

- i) All stipulations contained in the Official Memorandum issued by the Hon'ble High Court as per the reference 2nd cited, should be complied with.
- ii) The board indicating designation both in front and rear of the vehicle should be painted in red colour with letters in white and the height of the letter should be 60 m.m and thickness should be 8 m.m.


