*Sub:—*Motor Vehicles—Exhibition of name boards in Motor vehicle owned by Government Departments/Public Sector Undertakings—Further Instructions—Issued.

*Ref:—*1. Government Circular No. 5280/M2/94/PW&T dated 25-2-1994.
2. Government letter No.19580/M2/95/PW&T dated 23-6-1995.

In the circular cited instructions have been issued regarding the display of name board of each Department/Public Sector Undertakings with certain specification so as to identify them easily and to avoid misuse. But recently it has come to the notice of Government that many Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous bodies and local bodies are interested in exhibiting the name board 'KERALA STATE' instead of their name despite the clear instructions.

It is also observed that in certain vehicles the designation of officers are also displayed which is ridiculous and contrary to the existing instructions.

Certain vehicles owned by the departments do not also exhibit the name of the departments. The vehicles owned by the departments can exhibit the name of the department only. The name board 'Kerala State' is meant for Ministers and those similarly assigned. Hence those departments to whom the 'Kerala State' Board is not assigned should desist from using this name board immediately.

Government therefore once again reiterate that the instructions contained in the circular (copy appended) be strictly complied with all concerned.

The Motor Vehicles Department and the Police Department should ensure that these instructions are followed strictly.

Sub: --Motor Vehicles--Exhibition of name boards in motor vehicles owned by Government Departments/Public Undertakings/Corporations etc. --Reg.

Ref:--1. G.O. (Rt.) No. 823/81/TF&P dated 14-7-1981.

2. Circular No. 55/82/Fin. dated 7-9-1982.

Government have issued orders as per the G.O. first cited to exhibit the name of the Government Departments/Corporations/Boards on the body of the vehicles so as to identify the vehicles easily and also to check to some extent the misuse of the vehicles. As per the Circular dated 7-9-1982 referred to above, it was also directed that the name of the Department/Corporation/Board etc. may be written in the front and back i.e. just above the grill in front and to the left portion of the dicky in the rear as per the specifications mentioned therein. It has now come to the notice of Government that vehicles belonging to the Public Sector Units and Government Departments are not clearly displaying the identity of the Company/Board/Department which own them. In the circumstances, the following further instructions are issued for immediate compliance.

- (i) The Government departmental vehicles will exhibit a board each in front and rear, indicating the department to which they belong. The background of the board will be red and the letters will be in white.
- (ii) The vehicles allotted to the Ministers and those similarly assigned will bear the board, 'Kerala State' and a number. The background of the board will be red and the letters will be in white.
- (iii) The Public Sector Units' vehicles will not display 'Kerala State' board.

(iv) The vehicles owned by Public Sector Units/Boards will display a rectangular board in front indicating the name of the Public Sector Unit/Board on top and the letters "A State Government Undertaking" below the name of the Undertaking, and a circular board, in rear, indicating the name of the Company either in full or in appropriate abbreviated forms. The background of both the boards will be light blue and the letters in black.

(v) The size of the letters in all cases shall be that of the Registration letters and numbers prescribed in Rule 50 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules 89. The name shall be written in English in self-illuminating paints.
