You are also directed to remove the black film (sun film) if any pasted upon the safety glass, wind screen and side glass of all vehicles owned by Motor Vehicles Department within 7 days from today. The Assistant Transport Commissioner should ensure that the black film of any kind pasted upon the safety glass, wind screen and side glass of all vehicles owned by Motor Vehicles Department has been removed within the time limit and furnish a compliance report on or before 15.05.2012.
