Sub:- Motor Vehicles Department – Proper accounting of vehicle passing through the check posts – direction issued reg.

The Vigilance and Anti Corruption Bureau after conducting surprise check at various Motor Vehicles check post had pointed out that the officials on duty at check posts are not in the practice of recording the details of vehicles passing through the check posts properly. As you are aware the details of vehicles (class of vehicle, seating capacity, RLW, rate of tax etc.) are required to ascertain the correctness of action taken against a vehicles which passed through the check posts. According to the vigilance officials the registers meant for the purpose are either kept blank or incompletely filled up. As this is the position, all the officials attending the check post duty are warned to maintain a full flagged register showing the details of all the vehicles passing through the check post w.e.f. 01.11.2015. The proposed register should be made available to all the competent officials who inspect the check posts.

The controlling officers will ensure that the register proposed is maintained all the check posts functioning under their jurisdiction.
