## NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. No. /2009.-In exercise of the powers conferred by section 96 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, the same having been previously published under Notification No.2207/B2/2009/Tran dated the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2009 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1422 dated the 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2009 as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act, namely:-

## RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2009.
  - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- Amendment of the Rules.- In the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, in rule 191, after the existing proviso the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-
- "Provided further that fees for exhibiting the advertisement on a rolling screen shall be paid for the total area of all the advertisements exhibited on the rolls".

## **Explanatory Note**

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per the existing provisions in the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 payment of fees for exhibiting advertisement is prescribed as Rs.10 per 100 contimeter square for a period of one year. Since rolling screen used for a livertisement provides more advertisement than its actual area, Government have decided to include a provision in the said rules to provide that the fee for exhibiting advertisement in a rolling screen shall be paid for the area of all the advertisements exhibiting in the rolls.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
