# **ORDER**

As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, sanction was accorded for the extension of the period of contract of Fully Automated Services of Transport Department (FAST) Project in Motor Vehicles Department with M/s Electronics Corporation of India Limited (ECIL) for a period of six months from 01.01.2010 to 30.06.2010. The Transport Commissioner in his letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above informed that it is essential to replace the unserviceable equipments in order to continue better and faster services to the public. He therefore requested to authorise the Regional Transport Officers to procure and replace the unserviceable equipments and make payment and also to pay electricity and BSNL bills utilizing the Service charges collected by the Department, as approved by the FAST Project Monitoring Committee held on 18.05.2010.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to

accord sanction to authorise all Regional Transport Officers (i) to procure and replace the unserviceable equipments of FAST Project after certification to that effect by authorised service centres or National Informatics Centre (NIC), following buy back procedure, if any, at DGS&D rate or through tender process, if DGS&D rate is not available and make payment utilising Service charges, (ii) to pay the electricity and BSNL (Broad band connection) bills utilising service charges.
