Sub: - MVD – Issue of Computerized PUCC, Issue & renewal of licenses

– Clarification - guidelines issued – reg: -

Ref: - 1. This Office Circular No. 02/2007

2. This Office Circular No. 13/2008.

It has come to the notice that some of the Pollution Testing Stations are not complying with the guidelines issued in the regard, and issuing pollution Under Control Certificates to ineligible Vehicles.

Therefore you are directed take stringent action against violation of the guidelines and cancel the license in the following cases:

1. If found pirated software is being used.
2. If technically qualified persons is not available in the testing station.
3. If found issuing PUCC for vehicles other than those permitted in the license.

It is also brought to the notice that licenses can be issued with existing or upgraded equipments for vehicles manufactured up to a certain period as instructed in Circular No. 13/2008.

When an application is received for renewal, license can be renewed for issuing PUCC for such vehicles according to the equipment available with the applicant. The vehicles which can be tested by a particular testing station should be mentioned prominently in the license.

Above instruction shall be complied with scrupulously.
