Note:-The term the blind the deaf and dumb and the orthopedically handicapped means:-

A) The blind:-

1. Name

The blind are those persons who suffer from any of the following condition.

- a) Total absence of sight
- b) Visual acquity not exceeding 6/600 or 20/200 (emellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses.
- c) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse.

B) The deaf:-

The deaf are those person in whom the sense of hearing is non-functional for the ordinary purpose of life. Generally a loss of hearing of 70 decibels or above at 500, 1000 or 2000 frequency will make residual hearing non-functional.

C) The dumb:-

The dumb are those in whom the power of speech is non functional for the ordinary purpose of life.

D) Orthopedically handicapped:-

The orthopedically handicapped are those person who have a physical defect or deformity which causes an interference with the normal functioning of the bones, muscles and joints.
