Is there any byelaw for your Association? Is there any permission to interfere in disciplinary matters? Don't try to exceed your limits of association work. You will also be liable for disciplinary action then.


First of all read government rules well. Every officer is expected to stay within 15 kilometers of his headquarters. Every head of office is expected to attend office on occasions like hartal or strikes. If he is unable to attend, he has to hand over the keys of the office to the District Collector. These are the rules. No officer can leave his jurisdiction without sanction from his superior authority. If after coming to office, he is not allowed to enter or office cannot be

functioned then he has to seek the police protection and also inform the superior authority. Just by hearing that a hartal is declared unauthorisedly leaving the headquarters and jurisdiction and not attending the office cannot be allowed at all. So, the orders will stand for all those who did not come to office and were not even available in the headquarters. If any public gives complaint with proof that he could not make payment on that day and if it is seen that the head of office was not available in the headquarters, then he has to bear the fine as well as disciplinary proceedings.
