Committee on Road Safety - Suspension of Driving Licences for  
various offences & Checking of uninsured vehicles-reg:-

Ref:- (i) Direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court appointed Committee on  
Road Safety (Letter no.05/2014/CoRS-Part III dated 18.08.2015)  
(ii) Decision taken on the meeting of Deputy Transport  
Commissioners held on 02.06.2017 at Ernakulam

The Honorable Supreme Court appointed Road Safety Committee vide  
the letter 1<sup>st</sup> referred has instructed to suspend the driving licences for a period  
not less than three months for the following offences:-

- (i) Driving at a speed exceeding the specified limit which would also  
include red light jumping;
- (ii) Carrying overload in goods carriages and carrying persons in goods  
carriages;
- (iii) Driving vehicles under the influence of drink and drugs
- (iv) Using mobile phone while driving a vehicle

The Committee has also instructed to periodically check the vehicles to  
see whether the vehicle owners have third party insurance cover. In case they  
are not covered by third party insurance, it is instructed that the vehicle should

These directions were communicated to all enforcing authorities for strict implementation vide this office letters 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> referred. In the quarterly statements showing progress in implementation of these recommendations, it is observed that the number of cases for which licence is suspended is not proportionate to the number of above stated offences reported. Similarly there is disparity in the number of vehicles which are reportedly not covered by valid insurance and the number of vehicles detained and released. This data is being furnished to the Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on Road Safety and the figures are not justifiable.
