**ORDER**

As per the letter read above, the Transport Commissioner has furnished a proposal for the installation of Weigh-in-Motion bridges at 7 locations for an estimated amount of Rs. 500 lakhs. The proposal is envisaged to implement an integrated solution using latest innovations in information technology to automatically detect overloading in vehicles passing through border roads, maintain a list of records in computerized data form regarding the history of overloading offence of all vehicles passing through border roads and enable to detect overload offence in real time and thereby alert enforcement officers to take immediate action.

The Departmental Working Group Meeting held on 31/08/2022 has decided to accord Administrative Sanction for Rs 500 lakhs for the proposal by meeting the expenditure from the Head of Account '5055-00-050-97' subject to the condition that a pilot unit has to be installed and its performance to be monitored and found satisfactory before placing order for remaining units.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are

pleased to accord administrative sanction for the installation of Weigh-in-Motion bridges for an amount of Rs 500 lakhs by following Store Purchase Rules subject to the condition that;

1) A pilot unit has to be installed and its performance to be monitored and found satisfactory before placing order for remaining units.

2) If Weigh-in-Motion bridges are installed at Check posts where renovation works have been completed or are in progress, consider utilizing the facilities of said Check posts for monitoring system.

3) Feasible locations for installation and technical specification of the equipment shall be decided and approved by a Technical Committee formed for this purpose.

The expenditure in this regard shall be debited from the Head of Account '5055-00-050-97' under the current year's budget provision.
