Attention is invited to the above references. Vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited Government have forwarded the petition of Sri. Jobin Philip in which it is pointed out that tourist buses in Kerala are causing noise pollution by fitting sound system ranging from 15000 watts to 30000watts. Another compliant is that these vehicles are using spot lights, flasher, laser and a lot more lights inside and outside the bus which has now become a public disturbance and lead to accidents. You are directed to take action against these activities by conducting special checking Deputy Transport Commissioner are directed to furnish consolidated compliance report within 45 days.
