Attention is invited to the above reference. In its 89<sup>th</sup> Report for the year 2014-16, the Public Accounts Committee has opined that releasing the overloaded vehicle from other States after registering check repots is not tenable. The committee has recommended that overloaded vehicles from other States should be imposed with compounding fees at higher rate. In this connection it is directed that overloaded vehicles should not be allowed to without collecting compounding fee at higher rate and offloading the excess load as per the existing provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act and Rules.
