The PUCC certification validity prescribed for Bharat Stage IV Vehicles, as per Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989 (Amendment of CMV Rules, 115 (7) GSR 103 (E) dated 23/02/2012 is one year. Hence it is not possible, as proposed, to cut short the validity to 6 months and you are requested to strictly abide by the circular issued.

Further, with respect to upgradation of equipments, the responsibility for its timely execution is with the owners of the testing centers and as per existing guidelines, it was suppose to be carried out by 15th September 2016. Hence, you are also requested to ensure the up gradation without further delay.
