As per the letter cited above The deputy Director general & State informatics officer Kerala informed that many requests have been received from the department that there is compatibility issues in newly purchased equipments with SMART Move Software. Many offices of the MVD purchased the equipments they needed and later informed to this office that the equipment could not be used.

It may be noted that the Smart move Software was developed during 2001. The latest technology available at that time was used for t developing the software. Since then the technology has advanced considerably and there are may constrains in modifying Smart Move Application to adapt to advanced technology. Also it is impossible for certain brands of equipments to be compatible to Smart Move.

Hence all the officers and the purchase committees shall ensure while purchasing new equipment that the equipment they are purchasing are compatible to the SMART MOVE. For this a compatibility test shall be insisted as a mandatory condition for the purchase of the equipments.
