ORDER

As per the letters read above, the Transport Commissioner has reported that the involvement of the senior most officer of the department in the administrative affairs is highly necessary in the Transport Department for it to function effectively. The rich experience gained at various levels by the senior officers of the department are now left unutilized in transport administration. Therefore an officer of the department need to be appointed exclusively to aid the Transport Commissioner and the Additional Transport Commissioner in administrative matters. Transport Commissioner suggested that this can be achieved by appointing a Joint Transport Commissioner as done in all other southern States, re-designating the post of Senior Deputy Transport Commissioner and Secretary, State Transport Authority.

Government have examined the case in detail. In the circumstances reported by the Transport Commissioner, the post of Senior Deputy Transport Commissioner and Secretary, State Transport Authority is re-designated as Joint Transport Commissioner.

Necessary amendment in the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules and Kerala Transport Special Rules will be issued subsequently.
